# Supreme Court of Virginia- Office of the Executive Secretary Guidelines for Involuntary Civil Commitments and Related Mental Health Proceedings – Necessary Expenses



I. PURPOSE:

Establish guidelines for the payment of necessary expenses submitted on Form DC-60 INVOLUNTARY ADMISSION HEARING INVOICE.

II. APPLICABILITY

This guidance document applies to the following individuals who utilize Form DC-60 INVOLUNTARY ADMISSION HEARING INVOICE, to request payment of fees and expenses for involuntary civil commitments and other related mental health proceedings:

- Any special justice, retired judge sitting by designation pursuant to § 16.1-69.35, or any district court substitute judge
- Any physician, psychologist or other mental health professional, or any interpreter appointed for persons who are deaf, who is not regularly employed by the Commonwealth
- Any qualified evaluator as defined in § 16.1-336 who is not regularly employed by the Commonwealth
- Any attorney appointed to represent a respondent

#### III. DEFINITIONS:

**Necessary Expenses** 

Professional expenses incurred by appointed individuals while performing duties specifically related to involuntary civil commitments and related mental health proceedings as set forth on Form DC-60 INVOLUNTARY ADMISSION HEARING INVOICE.
